ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

1. Diploma in Christian Ministry (2 Years)

This program is designed for people called to serve the local church, related organizations and ministries. Students who enrol for Diploma in Christian Ministry will receive Biblical grounding and theological formation, be equipped for pastoral ministry and leadership, Christian counselling, and youth ministry and leadership.

Students in the program can specialize in areas of:

- a. Christian Counselling
- b. Christian Education
- c. Pastoral Ministry

2. Diploma in Child Development Studies (2 Years)

This program is designed for people called to serve children and youth as care givers, mentors, facilitators, and leaders. Students who enrol for Diploma in Child Development Studies will be exposed to child development theories, Biblical and theological foundations, legal frameworks and international conventions and networks for child development.

3. Bachelor of Theology (3 Years)

This program is for people who need higher level knowledge and skills for leadership, trainer and facilitator roles. Students who enrol for Bachelor of Theology will explore Biblical and theological foundations, leadership theory and practice, Church and organizational dynamics and development.

Students in the program can specialize in areas of:

- a. Christian Counselling
- b. Christian Education
- c. Pastoral Ministry

The Bachelor of Theology degree program is affiliated with Ndejje University.

Minimum Entry Requirements

- 1. Degree: 2 A' Level principal passes or its equivalent
- 2. Diploma: 1 A' level principal pass or its equivalent.
